# Biography

Appreciated for his authenticity, charisma and sensitive playing, Antoine Rivard-Landry is a 24-year-old pianist from Quebec, Canada. His passion for music and his love for the instrument, nurtured by his teacher Jennifer Bourdages, enabled him to perform in public from a very young age. His debut with orchestra in the *Orchestre Métropolitain's* *Airs de Jeunesse* concert series, at age 12, solidified his ambition to pursue a career as a soloist. This led him to win several prizes in local and national competitions, namely *the Orchestre Symphonique de Montréal* (OSM) competition and the *Orchestre de Trois-Rivières* (OSTR) competition, with whom he later played Bartók's Piano concerto no.3 under the baton of Jacques Lacombe. At 17 years old, Antoine is admitted at the prestigious Juilliard School of Music in the studio of Robert McDonald.

Antoine returned to Montreal in 2016 studying at the *Université de Montréal* with Jean Saulnier, where he finished his bachelor's and his master's degrees, while also leading an inspiring career as soloist, chamber musician and accompanist. He participated in many concert series in Montreal and performed in several venues, such as the *Chapelle historique du Bon-Pasteur*, and was invited on many occasions to give recital in the Orford Music festival.

His recent participation in the Orford Music Prize and *the Orchestre de l'Université de Montréal* concerto competition enabled him to perform Beethoven's Piano concerto no.3 in Montreal, and in Beirut, Lebanon, under the baton of Harout Fazlian, thus making his international debut as a soloist.

Antoine is now studying at the *Conservatoire de musique de Montreal* under the tutelage of Richard Raymond.
